 - A. As part of the Agency's initiative to simplify Temporary Assistance for Needy Families policy, this rulemaking eliminates the consideration of assets in determination of eligibility for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families. By eliminating the asset limit for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, families can be encouraged to build a savings fund that would assist them in maintaining self-sufficiency when they experience an employment setback.
 - B. This rulemaking is being proposed in accordance with an option provided under the 1996 Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act. Under this provision, states may exclude certain types of resources from consideration as an asset when determining eligibility. This rulemaking exempts pension plans, including accounts solely owned by an individual such as an Individual Retirement Account (IRA), 401 K and Keogh Plan, from consideration as an asset for TANF. Implementing this change will simplify the way these assets are considered for the TANF Program. In addition to these changes the rule will also raise the asset test to \$50,000.
